Scenarios

Diamondback moth scenario

- Have seen moths and around
 15 larvae per 10 sweeps in
 crop at very early flowering.
- Low soil moisture
- •Warm dry conditions forecast next two-three weeks.
- •Other pests: Early signs of aphids colonising flowering heads (1-2cm colonies in crop edge).

Establishment pest scenario

- Last season had a 'soft ending' and dry summer.
- •This year, we have just had an early (wet) break (20mm early April).
- Lucerne Flea is a known problem
- Planting canola and cereals
- •What are your pest management strategies for Lucerne flea?
